A note from the pastor...

Today's gospel is a dramatic example of the struggle between Jesus and the devil. Jesus is preaching with authority when a man with an unclean spirit yells out, calling Jesus by name and identifying him as God's Holy One. The power to name someone is symbolic of having control over that person. (For this reason Jews never used God's name because doing so would be like trying to exert power over God.) That tactic did not work and Jesus shows by healing the man that he is more powerful than the devil when he commands the unclean spirit to leave him. The devil puts up a fight but ultimately Jesus wins. To this day, the battle between Jesus and the devil continues. Each day we have to make decisions. Do we listen to Jesus or do we give in to the devil's temptations? Pray daily for the grace to do God's will and not let the devil have control over your life.

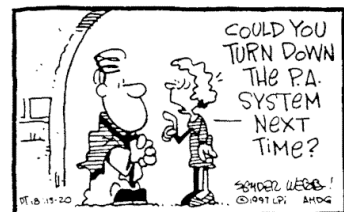
KofC FISH FEED The Knights of Columbus will be hosting their first annual Lenten Fish Feed this Lent.

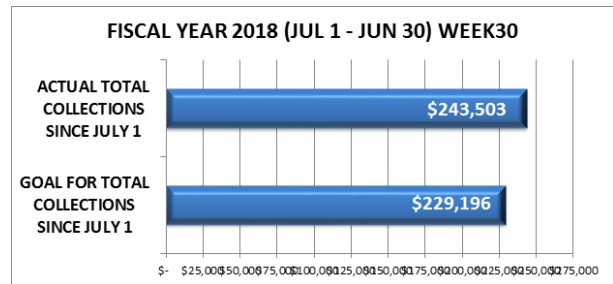
