A note from the pastor

For the first time since 1945, Ash Wednesday falls on Valentine’s Day. Right away we have to decide if we are going to take Lent seriously. On this day, any Catholic over the age of 14 is expected to abstain from meat and those between ages 18-59 are expected to fast, which means enjoying one full meatless meal, two smaller than usual meals and no snacking. Perhaps you have a romantic evening in mind but in the spirit of the season, I suggest that you consider celebrating that on another evening!

While Ash Wednesday might get our attention on the things we are giving up for Lent, I find that Lent has more lasting impact when we sacrifice some of our time to learn something new about our faith or enter more deeply into scripture or take our own spiritual journey more seriously. (Turn the TV or internet off for at least 30 minutes each evening to do that.) It gets the fire of the Spirit burning again, which is, after all, the real purpose of our Lenten journey. At Easter we want to be left with something more satisfying than a sense of relief that we made it to the finish line.

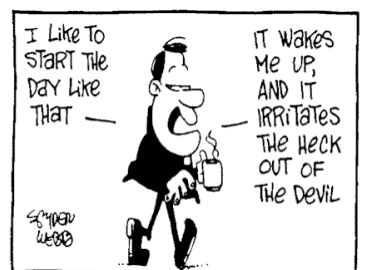

Clam Chowder and Lentil (vegan) soups - open to ALL



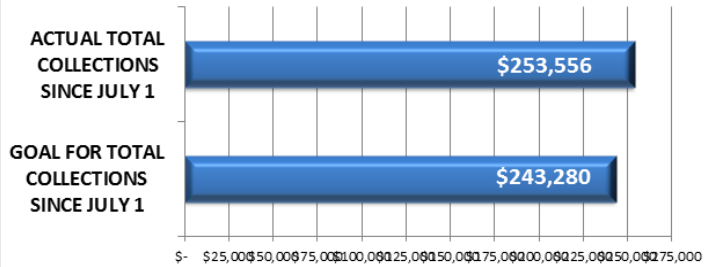
